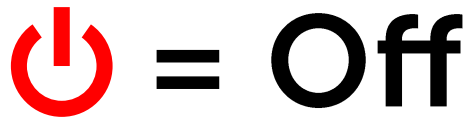

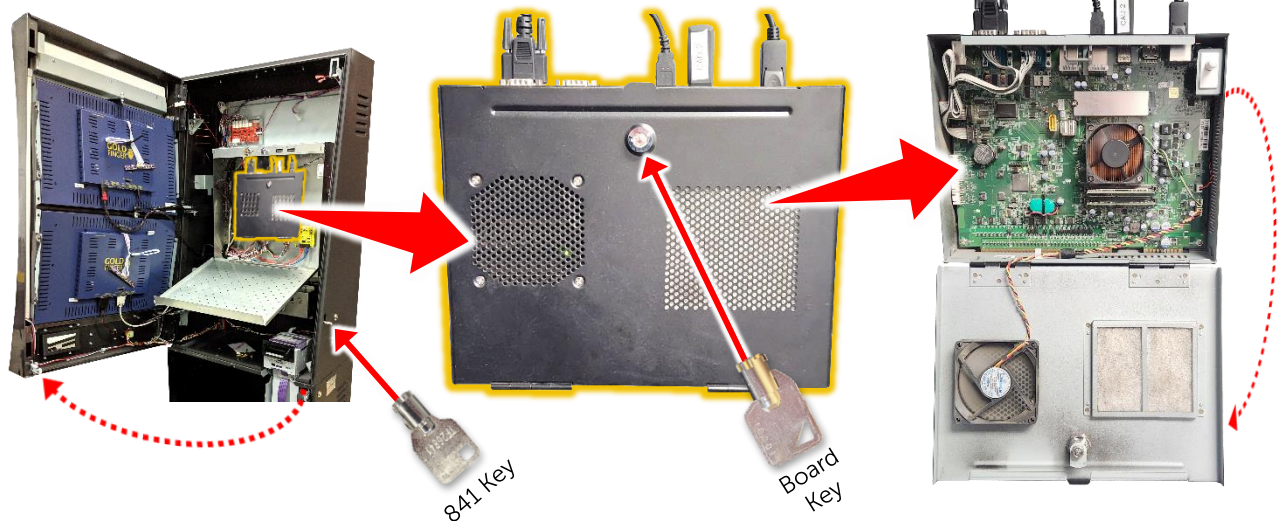


Warning: Power Off the Cabinet before opening or removing any internal components. Failure to power off the cabinet may result in damage to the internal components or possible injury.

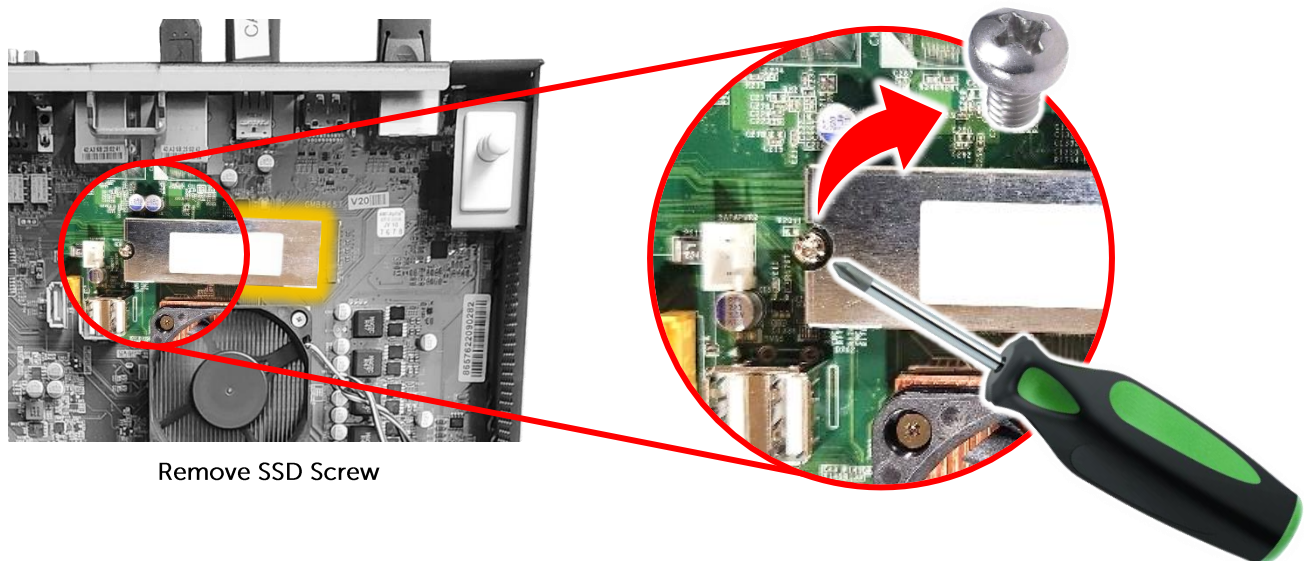
1. Power down the cabinet.



2. Open the Cabinet (841 Key) and the Game Board Box (EFCO Key).



3. Use the P1 Screwdriver to remove the Solid-State Drive (SSD) screw.



Remove SSD Screw

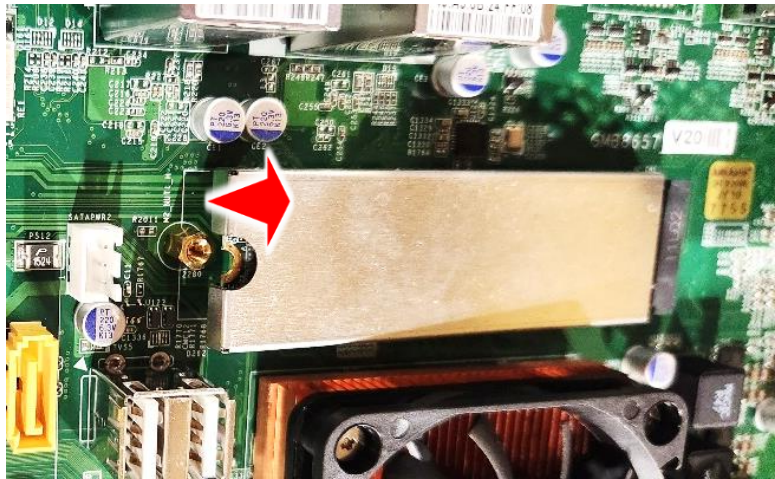


Warning: The SSD screw is easily lost. Use a Magnetic Screwdriver to prevent loss. If the screw needs to be replaced, use a **Machine Pan Head M3x4mm, Phillips Head** screw.

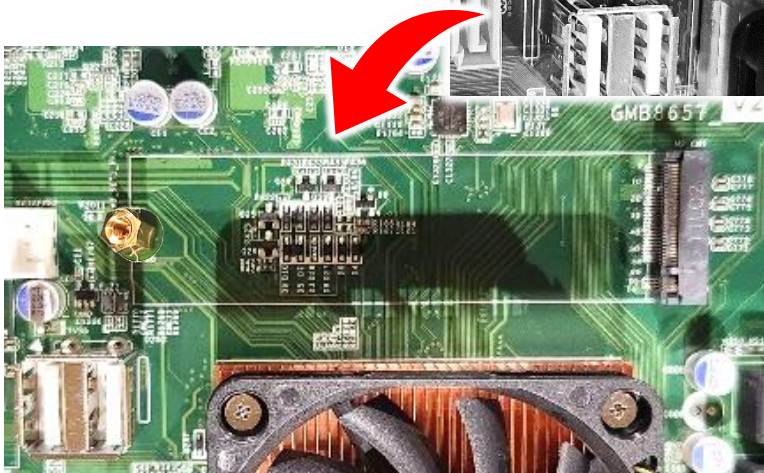
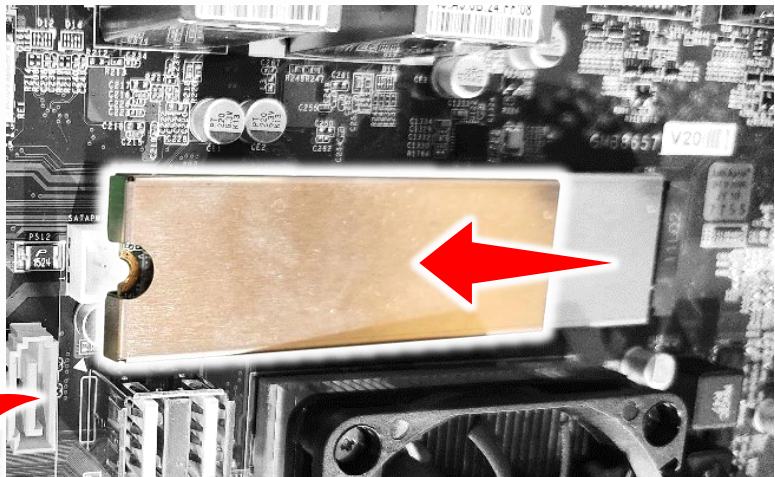

4. Slide the SSD Out from the connectors.



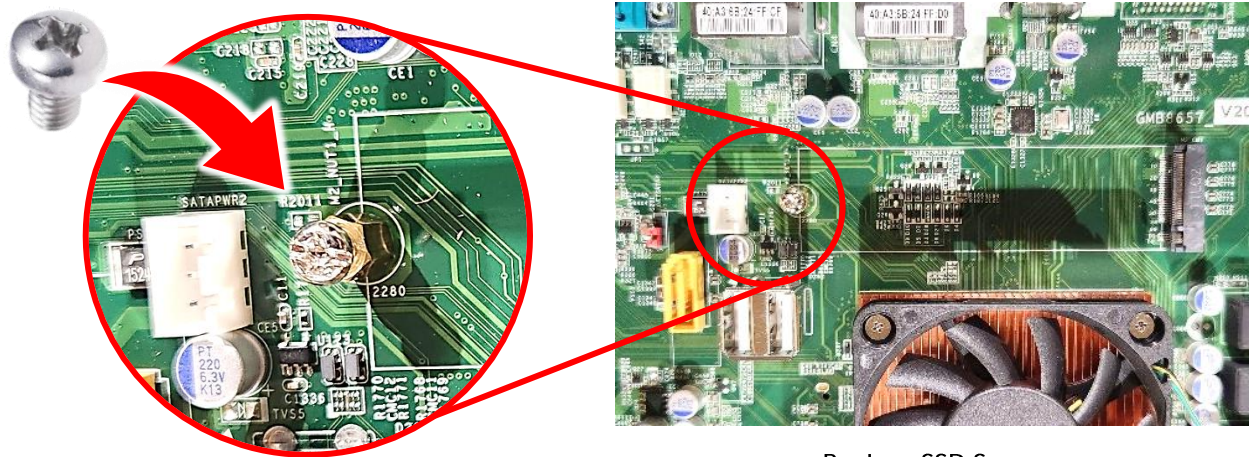
Slide SSD Out

Warning: The SSD screw is easily lost. If the SSD is not being immediately changed, replace the SSD Screw to prevent loss.

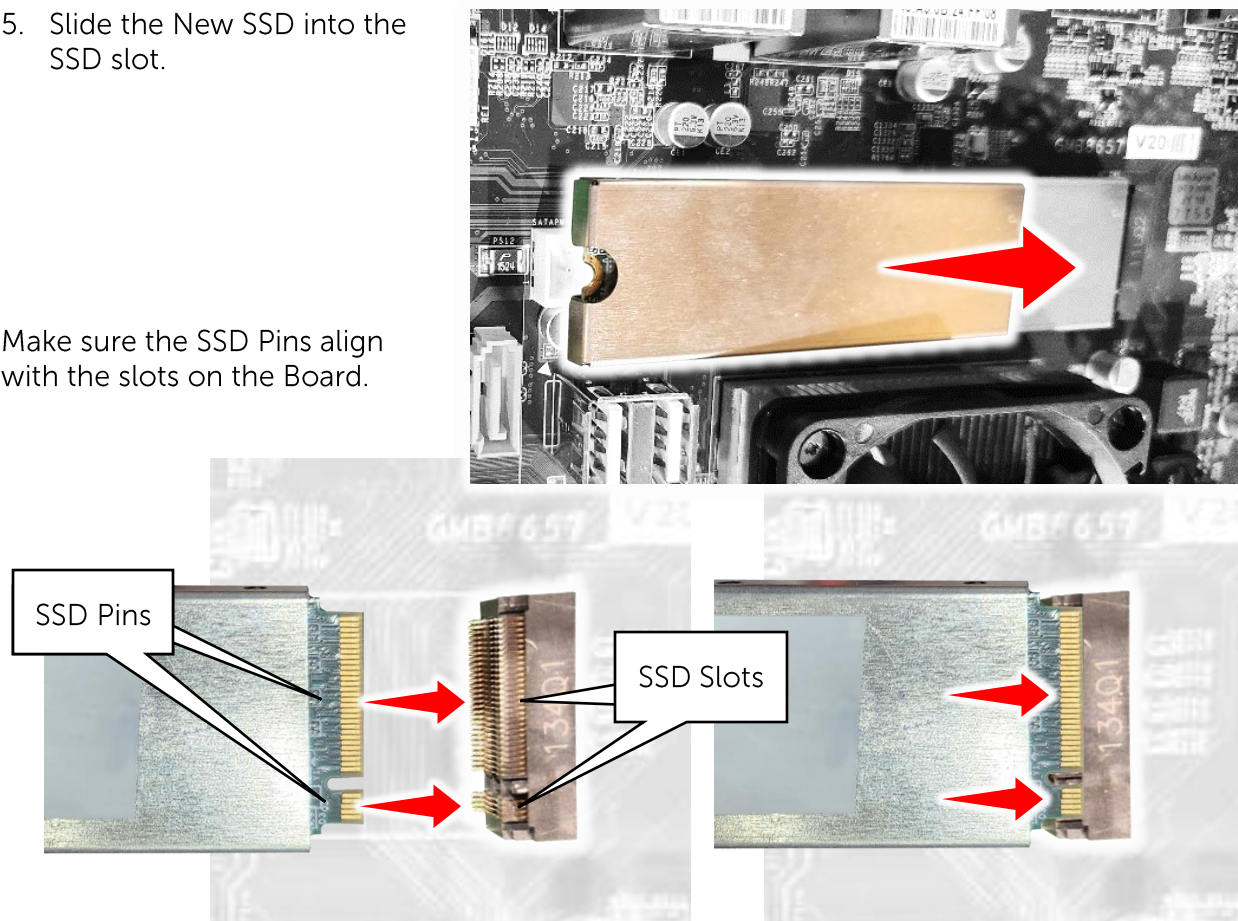
If the screw needs to be replaced, use a **Machine Pan Head M3x4mm, Phillips Head** screw.

5. Slide the New SSD into the SSD slot.

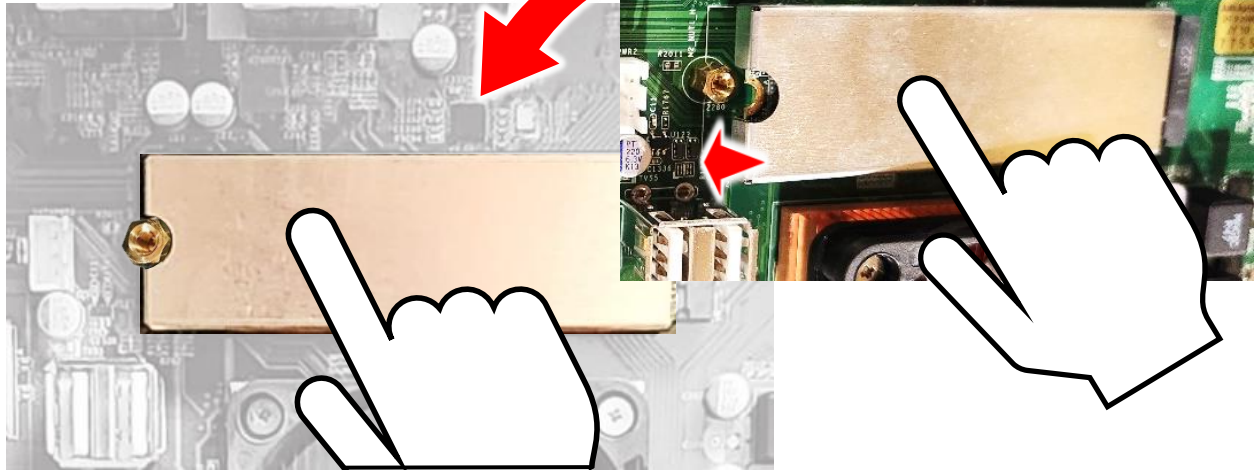
Make sure the SSD Pins align with the slots on the Board.



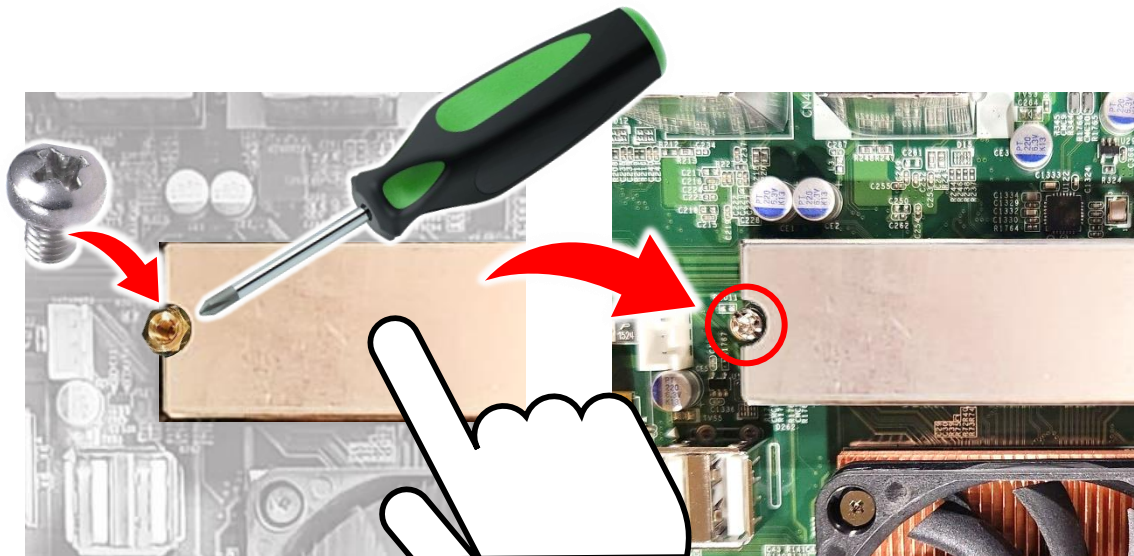

6. Lightly Press the SSD down and into place.



7. While holding the SSD down and in place, use the P1 Screwdriver to replace the SSD Screw.



8. Power the Cabinet back on and the Game should Boot up.

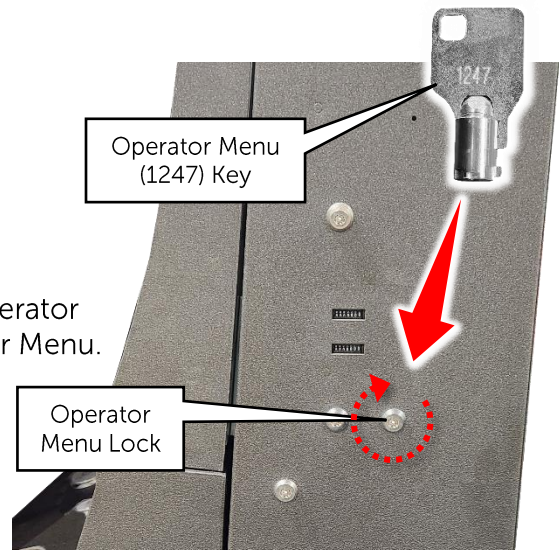


Game Not Activated

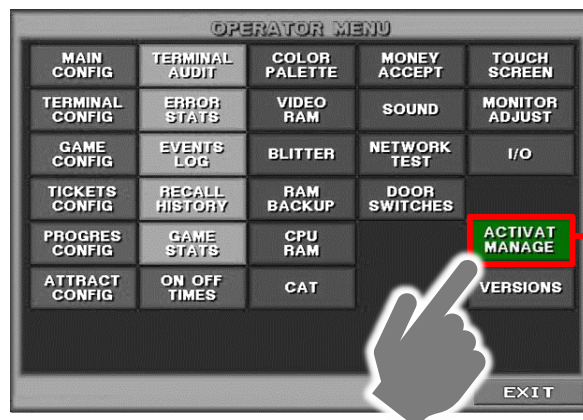
In some cases, the Game will show a CAT Status Warning indicating the game is not Activated. If this occurs, the Game will need to be Activated Manually.



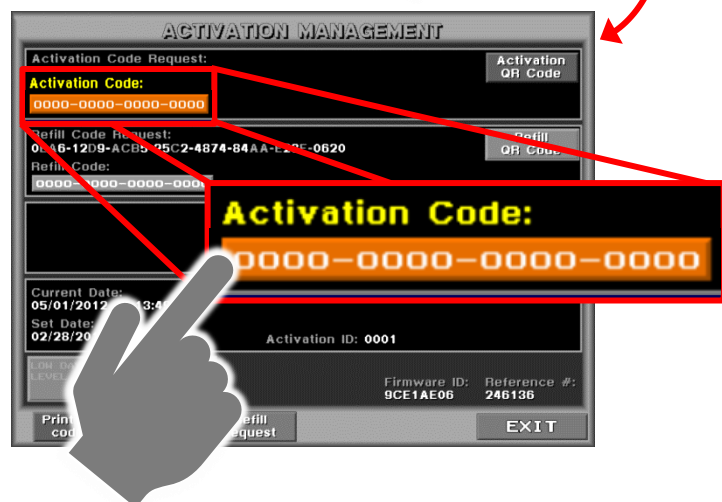
1. Insert the Operator Menu (1247) Key into the Operator Menu Lock on the Cabinet to access the Operator Menu.



2. Tap Activat Manage.



The Activation Management Menu opens.



3. Tap the Activation Code

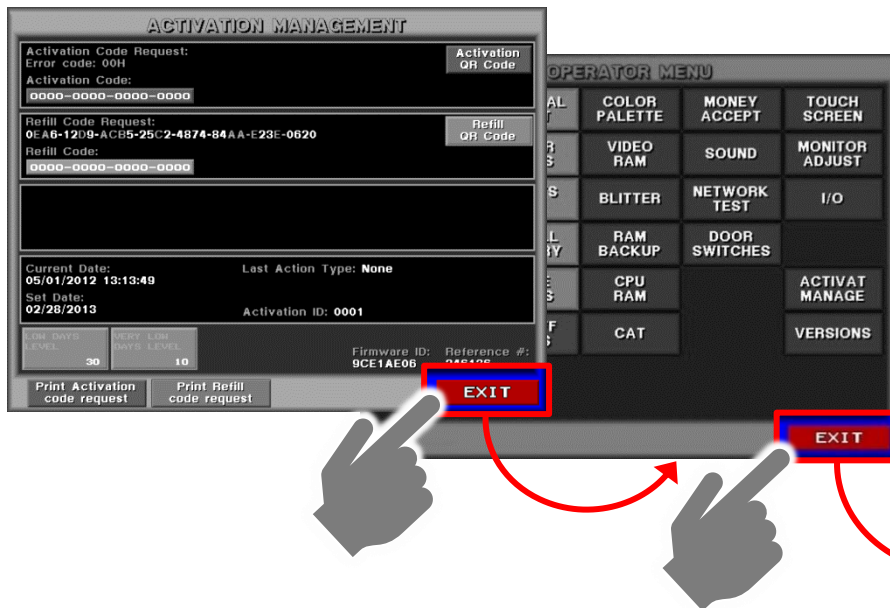


4. Enter the Activation Code on the Keypad and Tap OK.
